

TOEIC[®] Listening and Reading Test

Context	The TOEIC [®] Listening and Reading test is designed to assess a test taker's ability to understand explanations and instructions, follow public talks and announcements, understand workplace conversations and connect information in different real-world texts. Used by corporations, government entities and academic institutions to assess the English-language skills of potential employees or students, and by job seekers looking to prove their level of English proficiency.
